Deadline: February 15

Awards: 1,000 given - \$1,000 each

BYRON CENTER CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

Deadline: February 25
Criteria: Resident of Byron Center School District with a 2.5+ g.p.a., with plans to enroll in a 2 or 4 year college.
Award: 1 given to a SCHS student

CALVIN COLLEGE - FOR SOUTH CHRISTIAN HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ONLY

Deadline: February 15
Criteria: One application for all four scholarships. Turn in your completed application to the Guidance Office.

1. **Morren Family Scholarship** - For someone not already receiving a large scholarship from Calvin. 3.0+ g.p.a. Potential Calvin student who demonstrates Christian character, promise of growth, and participation and leadership in activities outside the classroom such as church, community, and extra-curricular school activities. One award is given.
2. **Roger & Sandra Alderink Scholarship** - No g.p.a. requirement. Student who demonstrates a Reformed Faith commitment as evidenced by involvement in volunteer organizations and activities, other than athletics, in church or school. Someone who does not qualify for other academic scholarships. One award is given.
3. **Theodore J. Peter's Scholarship** - Scholastic achievement, leadership, Christian commitment. 3.5 g.p.a. or a 25 ACT required. One award is given.
4. **Wilbur Lettinga Scholarship** - Demonstrates Christian character, leadership, promise of growth and participation and leadership in activities outside the classroom such as church, community and extra-curricular at school. 3.0+ g.p.a. One award is given.

Deadline: February 15
Criteria: Pursue a degree in engineering, 3.0+ g.p.a., 26+ ACT.
Awards: 36 - ranging from \$1,000 - \$3,000

MICHIGAN STATE TROOPERS ASSISTANCE FUND

Deadline: April 1
Criteria: Senior who plans to attend college or trade school, who has been involved in extra-curricular activities, community service, and jobs that make him/her productive members of their communities. 3.25+ g.p.a. required.
Awards: 20 - \$1,000 each

NATIVE AMERICAN TUITION WAIVER

Criteria: Legal resident of state for not less than 12 consecutive months. "North American Indian" means a person who is not less than ¼ quantum blood Indian as certified by the person's tribal association and verified by the Michigan Commission on Indian Affairs.
Awards: Free tuition in public state community colleges, public colleges, or public universities.

POLICE OFFICER'S & FIRE FIGHTER'S SURVIVOR TUITION ACT

Criteria: Must be a son or daughter of a Michigan Police Officer or Fire Fighter who was killed in the line of duty.
Award: College tuition waiver for any classes applicable toward a degree in the program in which the applicant is enrolled.

Deadline: April 1
Criteria: SCHS senior planning a major in healthcare or education or business. 3.0+ g.p.a. and financial need. Apply at <http://grcf.egrant.org> **and** mail a paper copy with transcript. Pick up a sheet in the Guidance Office with scholarship details.
Awards: 3 given to SCHS seniors

ROGER B. CHAFFEE

Deadline: February 28
Criteria: For a high school senior who intends to pursue a college career in engineering, math, or any of the sciences. Apply at www.rogerbchaffeescholarship.com Requires 2 letters of recommendation from science/math teachers.
Award: 1 - \$2,500

Deadline: March 1

Criteria: Senior with 3.0+ g.p.a., financial need, essay, active participation in civic and community service, dedication to civil rights principles. rosaparksscholarshipfoundation.org

Award: 1 - \$2,000
