Deadline: February 1

EASTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY PRESIDENTIAL

Deadline: November 25, must apply at EMU and fill out a scholarship registration form.
Criteria: No g.p.a.'s lower than 3.3 There is a calculation done on your ACT & GPA that must equal 61 points (see application).
Award: Minimum \$3,000 over four years & 16 full-ride, 29 - \$8,500

Deadline: January 15
Criteria: Senior planning to attend a CRC related college (Calvin, Dordt, Kuyper, Trinity, Redeemer, King's), requires a research paper.

Deadline: Apply to WMU by December 4
