Are you buying a calculator? Read the following to make sure you buy the correct one.

Algebra I & Geometry—any Texas instrument scientific calculator is sufficient.

Algebra II and FST—the Texas Instrument TI 83 model or TI 84 graphing calculator is required. **DO NOT BUY** the TI 85, TI 86 or TI 89; they are not the right calculator and many students have a difficult time if they try to use them.

Beginning with the 2008-09 season, all ticket prices for OK Conference games were raised to \$5 for adults and students. We realize this can create an expensive night out to watch an athletic event. For this reason, we encourage you to purchase a season pass for all South Christian home events. Please understand we are trying to balance the desire to have many fans cheering and supporting our athletes with the need to pay for the cost of a high school athletic program.

Another change is coming for the 2009-10 season:

There will be a \$5 entry fee to all sporting events at the Sports Park. This entry fee will allow you to watch all events occurring that day. This fee will be new to Baseball, Softball, and Tennis. We believe this will be more equitable to the soccer constituents who have been paying an entry fee for years.

Finally, our "tournament ticket sales policy" will continue to be in effect. Remember only students with season passes are sold tournament tickets ahead of general fans.
