**Connections** - Peer-led groups that consist of lunch partners, peer tutors and student leaders who build inclusion & belonging for our students with special needs within our school. This includes fun activities such as planning parties, outings, & service projects. Similar to Circle of Friends, the goal is for everyone to see and acknowledge the gifts God has given each individual and to use these gifts for God's glory.

**Dramatics** - Want to participate in some way in the fall drama or spring musical? Check this box and join in acting, set construction, hair and make-up, or working backstage.

**International Club**- Focuses on learning about other cultures. Members of the club will work with international students to showcase their cultures through short presentations for both students and staff to attend during the school day.

**Madrigals** - Auditioned chorus that meets once a week on Monday nights to rehearse. This group often preforms at other schools, festivals, and churches outside of school hours.

**Praise Team** – Leading worship is an opportunity to praise God and help others do the same thing. We have worship teams who help to lead their fellow students in chapel. If you play an instrument or sing, this would be a great place for you!

**Ski Club** - Join other students on Wednesday Nights at Bittersweet Ski area. Transportation provided based on weekly sign-ups. Ski cards offer a reduced rate and are available for purchase in the office.

**Stage Show** - Student Council-run talent show to help raise money for the Christmas Drive. Auditioned acts perform the first Saturday in December.

**Student Council** - Student leadership opportunity to represent your grade level. Meetings each month at lunch.

**Winterfest Committee** - Helping organize student involvement for a week of fun activities: dress up days, assembly, and Winterfest dance preparations.

**Young Life Campaigners** - Small group, multi-grade, student-led Bible studies on Friday mornings before school.

**Dance Team** - performs during home basketball games and school events. Throughout the year they represent South Christian and strive to be supportive of not only the dance program, but of all Sailor Athletic teams as well.

**Drumline** - Percussion ensemble that is open to anyone who wants to play percussion. We start from the beginning and teach technique so that anyone who wants to learn can participate. Rehearsals are on Tuesday mornings at 7:00 a.m.

**Jazz Band** - Auditioned band that experiments with, rehearses, and performs all different types of music: contemporary, jazz, swing, rock, pop, and ethnic music. You must also be a member of one of the school's bands to be eligible. Normally -Tuesday Night Practices.

**Marching Band** – Students registered in both Symphonic and Concert Band perform for home football games. Their practices begin with a week of camp at the beginning of August.

**Robotics** - Each year, students team up with several adult mentors, to design and build a robot. The team will also compete in several competitions through April. Students get to learn and participate in the design/build process and have opportunities to learn CAD, programming, metalworking, and other practical skills.

**Sound Technician** - Students are trained to run the sound system for our auditorium. Sound Technicians are used for events such as plays, musicals, Stage Show, and concerts.

**Student Ambassador** - Connecting new and inquiring students with students familiar with SCHS. The office will also need ambassadors to help host students interested in attending SC from time to time.

**Tabletop Club** - meets weekly after school for an hour to hang out and to play a variety of games: chess, checkers, Settlers of Katan and Dominion to name a few. All skill levels are welcome.

**Young Life Club** - Large group meetings on Monday nights where Young Life Leaders build authentic friendships with students and pray with them, provide fun, adventurous and life changing experiences while helping them grow in their faith.
