Art Club – This club is for anyone who is interested in creating art! We meet once/week after school from 3 – 4:30 and all are welcome. We supply what is needed to work with. You simply are invited to come and join the fun.

AV (Audio Visual) Club - Students are trained to run the sound system for our auditorium. Sound Technicians are used for events such as plays, musicals, Stage Show, and concerts.

Connections - Peer-led groups that consist of lunch partners, peer tutors and student leaders who build inclusion & belonging for our students with special needs within our school. This includes fun activities such as planning parties, outings, & service projects. The goal is for everyone to see and acknowledge the gifts God has given each individual and to use these gifts for God's glory.

Chamber Orchestra (Sailor Strings) - an audition-based group that meets Tuesday mornings to learn more advanced repertoire in a variety of musical genres and have more opportunities to perform in the greater community. Anyone playing a string instrument for at least 3-4 years is welcome to audition. Performances include orchestra concerts and participation in other opportunities as they arise.

Drumline - Percussion ensemble that is open to anyone who wants to play percussion. We start from the beginning and teach technique so that anyone who wants to learn can participate. Rehearsals are on Tuesday mornings at 7:00am

Field & Stream Club - The mission of the Field & Stream club is to help people explore and accomplish their outdoor activity goals such as going fishing, hunting, and participating in the great fun of the outdoors.

Gardening Club - Our mission is to help facilitate discovery and the fun of designing and setting up a Kitchen Garden; plant and take care of herbs, vegetables, and a pollinator garden; and watch them grow and change into a delicious harvest. Moreover, we will become critical thinkers, problem solvers, and stewards of a Holistic Health thinking-approach in our South Christian community.

Global Gatherings- This club meets at least once per month and facilitates connection between students from West Michigan and our international students. We meet to discuss and practice different cultural traditions and learn about cultures around the world. Club is open to anyone interested in learning about culture.

Jazz Band - Auditioned band that experiments with, rehearses, and performs all different types of music: contemporary, jazz, swing, rock, pop, and ethnic music. You must also be a member of one of the school's bands to be eligible. Usually Tuesday night practices.

Madrigals - Auditioned chorus that meets once a week on Monday nights to rehearse. This group often preforms at other schools, festivals, and churches outside of school hours.

Marching Band – Students registered in both Symphonic and Concert Band perform for home football games. Their practices begin with a week of camp at the beginning of August

Praise Team – Leading worship is an opportunity to praise God and help others do the same thing. We have worship teams who help to lead their fellow students in chapel. If you play an instrument or sing, this would be a great place for you!

Robotics - Each year, students team up with several adult mentors, to design and build a robot. The team will also compete in several competitions through April. Students get to learn and participate in the design/build process and have opportunities to learn CAD, programming, metalworking, and other practical skills.

Senior-led Bible Study - Small group, multi-grade, student-led Bible studies on Thursday/Friday mornings before school.

Ski Club - Join other students on Wednesday Nights at Bittersweet Ski area. Transportation provided based on weekly sign-ups.

Student Council - Student leadership opportunity to represent your grade level. Meetings each month at lunch.

Theater - Want to participate in some way in the fall drama or spring musical? Check this box and join in acting, set construction, hair and make-up, or working backstage.

Unified Sports - Students with and without intellectual disabilities join together in this club to foster inclusion through sport. They promote inclusion and belonging throughout our hallways providing all students with the feeling of being one student body and “togetherness”. Unified plays during the winter sport season, practices 3:15-4:30 on Tuesdays, and plays games on some Fridays!

Yearbook - this group works together to capture the memories milestones that occur throughout the school year. There are a variety of tasks: selling advertisements, photography, writing, editing & graphic design. Members often attend school events to take photos, interview students and staff, and gather content that highlights our school spirit. Meetings once a week, outside of school hours.

Young Life Club - Large group meetings on Monday nights where Young Life Leaders build authentic friendships with students and pray with them, provide fun, adventurous and life changing experiences while helping them grow in their faith.
