South Christian gained over 30 students this year and the trend continues. The projected enrollment is strong and we are grateful.


FAITHFUL STEWARDSHIP

Stewardship of our facilities is essential for the long-term health and sustainability of our school. Establishing a sinking fund ensures we can care for and maintain our physical plant without increasing tuition.





athletics

(PROJECT ESTIMATE \$276,000)

While the school building is new, the athletic facilities are 20 years old. It is time to invest in them.

- Hardwire internet access to soccer, tennis, and baseball/softball (\$150,000)
- Various fencing projects (\$50,000)
- Maintenance to lights on soccer field and tennis courts (\$30,000)
- Repair/replace retaining walls in tennis facility (\$30,000)
- Replace baseball scoreboard so it is visible in the afternoon sun (\$16.600)





auditorium

(PROJECT ESTIMATE \$80,000)

When the auditorium was built five years ago the lighting was adequate. However, better programming will expand new opportunities for students.

 Lighting upgrade in auditorium to include remote controlled lighting (\$80,000)

Sinking fund (PROJECT ESTIMATE \$343,400)

Establishing this fund will ensure that we can cover unexpected, unbudgeted maintenance and repairs without having to urgently fundraise to cover the need. This will reduce the need for putting a large unexpected expense on tuition paying parents.
