SOUTH CHRISTIAN HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

(October 2020)

These scholarships are <u>for SCHS students only</u> or are ones that were awarded to at least one SCHS student last year. Scholarships and deadlines may vary from year to year and will be advertised in the Guidance Office as new deadlines and applications become available.

- 1. Anna Elizabeth Stegink Memorial Senior who has overcome significant learning disabilities during their high school years. The student must demonstrate persistence and a positive attitude in meeting academic challenges, maximum use of his/her strengths to achieve success and show personal growth in the areas of independence and responsibility. No application required. Deadline: March
- 2. **Brink Wood Products** graduate from SCHS continuing post high school education 2 or 4 years at a college, university or trade school. Must meet financial need parameters and write a short essay. **Deadline: March**
- 3. *Buist Electric/Patrick Sterk Memorial* Senior with a 2.0+ g.p.a. who is motivated to enter post high school education at a 2 or 4 year college, technical or trade school. Students need not demonstrate outstanding academic achievement and should have overcome some obstacle, hardship or disability in life. Other criteria include: citizenship, high moral character, and demonstration of a positive attitude in the school community. Two awards are given.

Deadline: March

- 4. **Buist Electric** Senior with a g.p.a. of at least 2.0 who plans a career related to the electrical field including engineering, construction management, and computer-related careers. Two awards are given. **Deadline: March**
- 5. **Byron Center Chamber of Commerce** Resident of Byron Center school district with a 2.5+ g.p.a. who demonstrates character and citizenship, and plans to enroll in a 2 or 4 year college. One award is given. **Deadline: February**
- 6. *Calvin University Alto Precision Willis Clark* Senior with 3.0+ g.p.a. who is motivated to enter post high school education in engineering or a science field. One award is given. *Deadline: February*
- 7. *Calvin University /Jay & Kathleen Morren Family* For someone not already receiving a large scholarship from Calvin. 3.0+ g.p.a. Potential Calvin student who demonstrates Christian character, promise of growth, and participation and leadership in activities outside the classroom such as church, community, and extra-curricular school activities. Must also demonstrate financial need. One award is given. *Deadline: March*
- 8. *Calvin University / Theodore J. Peter's* Scholastic achievement, leadership, Christian commitment. All potential Calvin students with a minimum 3.5 g.p.a. or a 25 ACT are eligible. One award is given. *Deadline: March*
- 9. *Calvin University / Roger & Sandra Alderink Family* Potential Calvin student who demonstrates a Reformed Faith commitment as evidenced by involvement in volunteer organizations and activities, other than athletics, in church or school. No GPA requirement. Someone who does not qualify for other academic scholarships. One award is given.

Deadline: March

- 10. *Calvin University / Wilbur Lettinga* Demonstrates Christian character, leadership, promise of growth and participation and leadership in activities outside the classroom such as church, community and extra-curricular at school. All potential Calvin students with a 3.0 g.p.a. are eligible. One award is given. *Deadline: March*
- 11. *Cutlerville Chamber of Commerce* Student who resides in Cutlerville or Gaines Township that demonstrates character and community involvement and service while maintaining high academic standards. Three scholarships are divided between Byron Center High School, Caledonia High School, Kentwood High School, South Christian High School and Home schooled students. *Deadline: March*
- 12. *Grand Valley Trotter Tri-County* Seniors must have a 3.2+ g.p.a. with a minimum ACT composite score of 22 or SAT score of 1110. Ideal nominees are those who are not receiving another GVSU merit-based scholarship. No application is required. Will be chosen by the SCHS Scholarship Committee. Two awards are given. *Deadline: March*
- 13. *Kentwood Women's Club* Senior, female resident of Kentwood. One girl will be chosen from either SCHS <u>or</u> Kentwood High School. *Deadline: February*
- 14. *Luke Kuperus Memorial* For a senior who is pursuing further education in a diesel or automotive mechanic program or in agricultural sciences. *Deadline: March*
- 15. *Natasha Meyer-Turner Memorial* Continuing education at Calvin University. 3.0+ gpa. Write a short essay about how you have demonstrated acts of kindness and compassion. *Deadline: March*
- 16. *Paul D. Landhuis Memorial* For a SCHS senior who is pursuing a degree in Youth Ministry, Worship Arts or any other ministry-related field. Must submit an essay and describe a personal difficulty or struggle in your life and how you have overcome it. GPA requirement 3.0+. Preference given to students attending Kuyper College (1st) Huntington University (2nd) or elsewhere (3rd). *Deadline: March*
- 17. Roger & Jacquelyn VanderLaan Family/Grand Rapids Community Foundation SCHS senior planning a major in healthcare, education, or business. 3.0+ gpa and financial need. Apply at <a href="majority-grand-arrow-green-gree
- 18. **South Christian High School Music Boosters** Completion of 6 semesters of Music and/or Art classes at SCHS. Plans to major or minor in music after graduation. **Deadline: March**
- 19. **South Christian High School Sports Boosters** 2.5+ g.p.a., demonstrated an example of a Christian lifestyle on and off the SCHS campus, leader, involved in 2 varsity sports per season for at least 2 seasons. Awards are given to two boys and two girls. **Deadline: March**
